## BATTLES WON PRIVATELY ARE THE BASIS FOR ALL PUBLIC VICTORIES

This is what happens when you are bigger on the inside than on the outside. Intimately acquainted with the Lord, David led back-to-back victories while tending his father's sheep. He even outclassed lions and bears. You can't lose when God is your silent partner. David never changed who he relied on even in his fight with Goliath. On the day of battle, he was sent to deliver food to his enlisted brothers. David was too young to be in King Saul's army and too small to wear his armor. "For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are", 1 Corinthians 1:26-28. David only used what was familiar to him. Armed with his slingshot and stones, David ushered the God of the armies of Israel into the battle as his concealed weapon. Goliath, the enemy could not see his invisible conquering force. Having all doubts dissolved, David knew the same God who won while he was doing his chores at home would also conquer the battle for the nation. After the initial blow with the stone, David used the enemy's sword to cut off his headship. Many think the fight on the battlefield gave him national acclaim. In reality, the fixed fights no one else saw pulled him into his destiny. His praise enthroned God. He won as the shepherd boy with the king's anointing. "...Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world", 1 John 4:4. Never underestimate who you are in Christ. Never overestimate who you are without Christ.

## JESUS FOUND HIMSELF IN THE WORD; IT BECAME AN INDELIBLE IMAGE

Being born into the world, Jesus had to rediscover His destiny as a human. As Jesus read the Old Testament (*Torah*), He found the script He was to live out.
