TRANSCEND YOUR HOPE BY REMOVING ANY PRESENCE OF LOSS

The Tree of Life is proof that nothing is ever lost within the kingdom of God. The Bible records it in the first book, Genesis and the last book, Revelation. How is it restored? The resurrection power of Christ gave new life to what appeared to be lost forever. Job 14:7-9 reveals, “For there is hope of a tree, if it be cut down, that it will sprout again, and that the tender branch thereof will not cease. Though the root thereof wax old in the earth, and the stock thereof die in the ground; Yet through the scent of water it will bud, and bring forth boughs like a plant.” Hope sown is not buried alive. “Hope deferred maketh the heart sick; but when the desire cometh, it is a tree of life”, Prov. 13:12. Refuse to dig up your seeds by rehearsing contrary words. “A wholesome tongue is a Tree of Life; but perverseness makes a breach in the spirit.” Prov. 15:4. Tongues plot destination to life or death. Stay connected to Holy Spirit so He can lead you into a voluptuous lifestyle. Challenge every hostile hope. If you or anyone speaks words to extinguish your hope, say aloud, “I break the power of those negative words; that will not come to pass in my life. You cannot re-route my destiny to the Tree of Life with premature death”. Be unyielding about re-securing the newness of life Jesus restored. It is far better than the life Adam and Eve enjoyed before the “Fall”. Be resolute to live dependent upon God. He only has one desire: restitution. Anything created can be re-created better than what was lost. “Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.” Isaiah 43:18-19.

GOD’S CREATIVE TEAM REPOSITIONS YOU TO TAKE YOUR HOPE BACK

An event is never your eventuality, unless you think it’s permanent. First, God is present to resuscitate you back to life. Then He reinvents your dream. Two change agents realize the glory of God: the Word of God images your hope; and the Spirit of God empowers it. Without them, it remains impossible to create or re-create anything by faith. The Word gives indisputable proof of overcoming hopelessness. “For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope”, Romans 15:4. In concert with the Word, Holy Spirit transforms us to see Jesus as He is so we can be as He is in this world. That supernatural change in us re-presents Jesus to our world. He takes us from one level of glory to the next so we can live beyond, never live with, hopelessness. “Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost”, Romans 15:13.

DOWNLOADING RHEMA FROM HEAVEN IS THE ANCHOR OF YOUR SOUL

Abraham was quite significant to God’s plan. For over two decades, the Lord worked His hope into him until he received the promised heir. Romans 4:17 is the *rhema* word He deposited into Abraham prior to conception as well as His system of operation for us. “... I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were [*rhema*].” In verses 18-19, Abraham finally believed God, not just believed in Him. “Who against hope believed in hope, that Abraham might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken [*rhema*], So shall thy seed be. And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah’s womb: [barren for 90 years]”. God’s hope of glory dissolved every doubt. Abraham took God at His *rhema* which activated his faith to receive the impossible,— the substance of *rhema* hoped for and the evidence of *rhema* unseen. “He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what He had promised, He was able also to perform,” Romans 4:20-21. God has chosen you to be the hope in His plan. Listen for His small, still voice to perpetually penetrate your soul. The *rhema* you receive makes heaven-born possibilities, predictable.

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Thought for Transformation
Doubts dissolved! “This is God’s Word on the subject:...I have it all planned out—plans to take care of you, not abandon you, plans to give you the future you hope for”, Jeremiah 29:11, The Message. Vow validated. “Accordingly God also, in His desire to show more convincingly and beyond doubt to those who were to inherit the promise the unchangeableness of His purpose and plan, intervened (mediated) with an oath”, Heb. 6:17, Amp.

Hope Under Protective Care
Hope is under the protective custody of God’s armor. “...be alert, with faith and love as our breastplate and the hope of our salvation as our helmet.” 1 Thes. 5:9, (Phillips). God’s thoughts of peace in you are guarded until you receive the expected end He prearranged for you. You won’t ever be left disappointed.
