HOLY SPIRIT FILLS TO OVERSPILL YOU TO SPILL OVER INTO OTHERS

You can see the laborious nature of drawing water from the story about the woman at the well in John 4th chapter. The well was deep. The daily trip was long. The bucket was weighted. Jesus introduced her to the supernatural favor of God so she could receive perpetual springs of water that never dried up. Since Jesus received Holy Spirit without measure, He was totally loaded and fully equipped to offer her satisfaction from any level of craving. He spoke endless life into her while His Holy Spirit drenched her to help her worship God in spirit and in truth. She brimmed with the newness of life: what was deposited was so fulfilling that she left her water pot at the well. From the overflow, she led others to the spout. Her insatiable hunger and thirst were finally satisfied. With the camaraderie of Holy Spirit, possess an endless gusher now. If you are craving anything, invite Holy Spirit to overspill so your thirst is quenched. Anything the flesh desires is subject to stoppage or shortage.

GOD'S DESIRE IS ALWAYS MORE FULFILLING THAN YOUR OWN

Jeremiah presents two scenarios. The first verse is a people who attempt to fulfill their craving without God. “My people are guilty of two evils: They have abandoned Me, the spring of living waters; *And instead, they have settled* for dead and stagnant water from cracked, leaky cisterns of their own making,” Jeremiah 2:13, The Voice. The second Scripture shows those who recognize their real need then ask God to heal the breach and then fill the void. “Jeremiah (to God): But from the beginning, Your throne of glory, our holy place, has always been exalted. O Eternal One, the hope of Israel, all who forsake You will be put to shame. Those who turn their backs on You will be written in the dirt, because they have forsaken You, the spring of living water. Heal me, O Eternal One, and I will be healed. You alone can save me; to You alone do I sing my praise,” Jeremiah 17:12-14. It's your choice!

THE MEASURELESS FLOW OF THE ANOINTING OF HOLY SPIRIT

John 3:34, AMPC represents Jesus' earthly ministry. “For since He Whom God has sent speaks the words of God [proclaims God's own message], God does not give Him His Spirit sparingly *or* by measure, *but* boundless is the gift God makes of His Spirit!” Then in John 7:37-39, Jesus promised all of us the same once we are born again. “In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto Me, and drink. He that believeth on Me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake He of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)” First, invite Jesus Christ into your heart. Then ask His Holy Spirit to rise up and live big in you! Finally, give His presence within you the power until your world looks like His.

HOW YOU HEAR CHANGES EVERYTHING ABOUT YOU AND AROUND YOU

“Husbands, you must love your wives so *deeply, purely, and sacrificially* that we can understand it only when we compare it to the love the Anointed One has for His bride, the church. *We know* He gave Himself up completely to make her His own, washing her clean of all her impurity with water and *the powerful presence* of His [spoken] word. *He has given Himself* so that He can present the church as His radiant bride, unstained, unwrinkled, and unblemished—*completely free from all impurity*—holy and innocent before Him,” Ephesians 5:25-27, The Voice. As you look in the written Word, you see God's love modeled before you. As you receive His spoken Word, you keep looking in the mirror of Holy Spirit until you see the image of Jesus Christ looking back at you. Psalm 107:35, Voice gives you vision “...He transforms a *dry, lonely* desert into pools of living water, parched ground into lively springs.” If you still see yourself, you may be leaking. Holy Spirit and the Word qualifies even those who may think they can't ever qualify. Boost your appetite!
